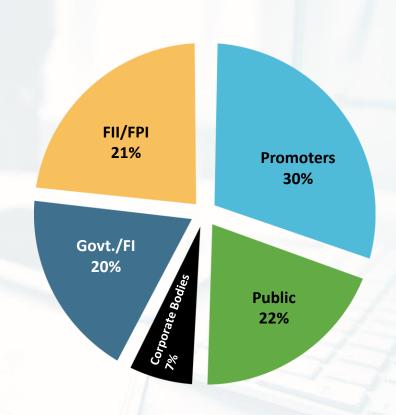

In consolidated results, they include effect of unrealised loss on fair valuation of derivative contracts amounting to Rs. 221.44 crores and Rs. 520.54 crores for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2018, respectively, and unrealised exchange gain amounting to Rs. 16.24 crores and Rs. 29.37 crores for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2018, respectively.

These interim financial information have been reviewed by other auditors and our report on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

- 2. Exceptional items represent effect of steep foreign exchange fluctuations in recent periods on fair value of the derivative contracts and foreign currency monetary items.
