The conscious decision to sell these ships is in line with the Company's overall strategy of reducing its presence in the non-double hull tanker fleet.

The Company's current fleet stands at 47 vessels, comprising 34 tankers (12 crude carriers, 20 product carriers, 2 LPG carriers) and 13 drybulk carriers (1 Capesize, 2 Panamax, 1 Supramax, 6 Handymax, 3 Handysize) with an average age of 10.7 years aggregating 3.14 mn dwt.
