

G E Shipping brings down costs to boost bottom line

The Great Eastern Shipping Company Ltd., (G E Shipping) had appointed Accenture to conduct a re-engineering exercise which resulted in cost savings of Rs. 14 crores in FY 2000-01. With process integration and systems orientation in place, the company is now targeting an aggressive cost reduction of around Rs. 22 crores for the financial year ending March 2002.
